

TOBACCO-FREE ZONE

The Grass Lake Community Schools is a TOBACCO FREE ZONE. Tobacco in any form - cigarettes, chewing tobacco, cigars, pipes, electronic cigarettes, etc. - will be prohibited from being used at any time. School buildings, parking lots, private vehicles on school property, athletic fields, and school vehicles are included. The Grass Lake Community Schools' Board of Education passed this policy on January 13, 1992 and was last revised on August 22, 2011. It is not the district's intention to restrict anyone's rights, but to protect the health and safety of all. Community cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
