To All Warrior Fans,

Recently the MHSAA has announced that spectator limits for sporting events are now increasing from 2 people per participant to 30% of the stadium capacity outside and 20% of the indoor capacity. This change has required us to look at the system we currently have in place and see what adjustments need to be made in order to allow as many spectators as possible into our events.

For home events the Grass Lake Athletic department will be using the following protocol:

1. We will still have the list that allows two guests per athlete to make sure that family members are able to come to the event. We will be extending the same courtesy to our visitors as well.
2. After we have established the list number we will figure out what is left and open them up for sale to the public. All ticket sales for home events will be done online through our ticketing website: Ticket Spicket. We are currently working with them to get the events on-line and the tickets up for sale. Because we are preselling we have to offer these tickets 50/50 with the visiting team until the day of the game. On the morning of the game, we will reopen the sales, if tickets are still available, and sell them until we reach our capacity.

For away events, we will be working with the host school to determine what their process will be and will do our best to communicate that information as soon as possible.

For the Michigan Center Football game on 10-9-20 at Michigan Center we are doing the following:

1. We will send our list of two spectators per player as we have been.
2. JV and Varsity football players will have the opportunity to purchase extra tickets first with a limit of two each. Sale of these tickets will be done at the Wright House at 11689 Morrissey (questions can be sent to 517-414-7641), as the building is closed to outside visitors during the day.
3. Remaining tickets will go on sale Thursday night at 6:00 pm, at the Joe Bechtel Ticket booth. These tickets will be sold first come first serve and will be limited to two tickets per person. Tickets are \$5 and exact change is preferred.

We understand that this will not allow everyone who wants to come to the games the chance to do so, but we are happy to be able to allow additional people the opportunity to come experience Warrior athletics in person. For those unable to attend home events will be streamed on the NFHS Network online. The camera in the gym was activated last night with the one on the football field being activated by our next home football game. There is a subscription charge for this and you will have the option of either a monthly or annual subscription.
