

All Grades Recommended Supply List 2021-2022

(Please remember these items are needed for the entire school year, not just in August)

We are asking as many students as possible to bring in Kleenex and Clorox wipes and give them to your 1st hour teacher

If your child is entering the 6th grade recommended supplies are:

- Earbuds and/or headphones (replacement pair recommended)
- **PENCILS (lots and lots)** and erasers (supply your own throughout the year)
- highlighters
- Colored pencils (used in all classes and a replacement package for when they are getting low)
- Notebook paper
- **ELA** - (1) 1 subject spiral notebook labeled with their name to keep in the room all year, (1) 2-pocket folder, colored pens for editing and revising writing pieces
- **MATH** – (1) 1” binder (1) 1 subject Spiral Notebook (1) 2-pocket folder
- **SCIENCE**- (1) one-subject notebook w/pocket or folder with pocket, (1) 12-pack colored pencils, (1) glue stick, (1) dry erase marker - all materials to be kept in class
- **SOCIAL STUDIES** - (1) one-subject spiral notebook
- **Optional:** wireless mouse, pencil bag, thumb drive or jump drive
- **We don't recommend Trapper Keeper type binders, as they become very heavy to carry with chromebooks throughout the year.**

If your child is entering the 7th grade recommended supplies are:

Each student must have a thumb drive or jump drive.

The 7th-grade team **Strongly recommends** a different colored folder or binder for each core class

- **LOTS** of pens (blue/black) & **pencils (lots & lots)**, erasers, highlighter
- Pencil case/zipper bag to hold above mentioned items
- Loose leaf notebook paper
- Headphones or earbuds (replacement pair recommended)
- **MATH:** (4) two-pocket folders with prongs, red or other bright colored pens, dry erase markers, multiple glue sticks, composition notebook for notes, (2) spiral notebook(s) for practice/homework
- **SCIENCE:** 2-pocket folder (1), spiral notebook, LOTS of pencils, markers
- **SOCIAL STUDIES:** 2-pocket folders, pack of colored pencils, pack of multi-colored highlighters, and fine point black Sharpie, and headphones or earbuds.
- **ELA:** composition book to be kept in the room all year

If your child is entering the 8th grade recommended supplies are:

Each student must have a thumb drive or jump drive.

- **General Supplies:** Pens/pencils/erasers - EVERY CLASS, EVERY DAY
Earbuds/headphones, Colored pencils, Loose leaf paper, Planner, either digital or paper
- **MATH:** 1” or 1 ½” 3-ring binder with pockets, red or other bright color pens (not purple); Pencils - lots of them; dry erase markers; spiral notebook(s) for practice/homework; **ALG8 additional supplies** - 1 composition book for notes, glue sticks
 - donation of 4 AAA batteries for graphing calculators is greatly appreciated
- **SPANISH:** notebook only used for Spanish, earbuds/headphones are used often, coloring supplies, dry erase markers needed throughout the year, it's nice to have a mouse in this class!
- **AMERICAN HISTORY:** Composition notebook and 2 sharpened pencils EVERYDAY!
- **SCIENCE:** Spiral Notebook, pencils sharpened EVERYDAY, 2 pocket folders, 4 dry erase markers any color (to be left in class), 12-pack colored pencils (to be left in class), glue stick (to be kept in class)
- **ELA:** 2-pocket folder; writing utensils

For Choir Students

The following supplies are required to store in your choir cubby in the choir room at all times:

- 2 - Pocket folder with 3 prong fasteners for music
- 1 - 2 pencils and 1-2 highlighters to keep in your folder
 - (optional but recommended) water bottle to keep our voices well hydrated!

6th

- All Students - Standards of Excellence Book #1 (red)
- Clarinet, Saxophone players - 3 to 5 reeds to begin the year with (more will be needed second semester, I would recommend Vandoreen 2.5 reeds)
- Trumpet, Baritone - Valve Oil
- Trombone Slide - Grease
- Percussion - Snare Sticks (preferably Vic Firth SD1 General), Medium Hard Yarn wound mallets (preferably Mike Balter Brand), Hard plastic tip xylophone/bell mallets. A stick bag is not required, but is very helpful to keep everything together and safe.
- Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, and Trombone players need their own instrument

7th and 8th -

- All Students - Standards of Excellence Book #1 (red, we will use it for review)
- Clarinet, Saxophone players - 3 to 5 reeds I would recommend Vandoreen 3 reeds
- Trumpet, French Horn, Baritone, Tuba - Valve Oil and slide grease
- Trombone Slide - Grease
- Percussion - Snare Sticks (preferably Vic Firth 5A), Medium Hard Yarn wound mallets (preferably Mike Balter Brand), Hard plastic tip xylophone/bell mallets. A stick bag is not required but is very helpful to keep everything together and safe.
- Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet, and Trombone players need their own instrument
